


















View of Surfers Paradise beach showing the 'Dunes', 'Sands' and 'Sahara Court' accommodation houses (1967)

The fast-food chain operates from a rented outlet in Cavill Avenue alongside Grundy's and this will eventually be closed when McDonalds transfers its opera-







