Palm Springs Modern Committee




Palm Springs Preservation Foundation


Palm Springs Art Museum



Between 1950 and 1974, Joseph Eichler partnered with some of the most progressive and well respected architects and architectural firms (including Anshen + Allen, A. Quincy Jones, Claude Oakland and Raphael Soriano) to build more than 11,000 modernist Eichler homes. All of which are easily discernable by their open floorplans and floor-to-ceiling glass which help blur the line between indoor and outdoor living.











Recognition and protection






- 1. Broaden the scope of 20th C heritage from archi-centric focus
- 2. Integrate/include 20th C in heritage studies
- 3. Make public awareness a 1st step or integral part of identification programs
- 4. Be judicious in selection to build public confidence

Recognition and protection



- 5. Acknowledge practical & technical issues & provide guidance to owners at time of listing
- 6. Recognise 20th C places can be significant without being design icons
- 7. Enjoy popularity of stylistic revival but build long-term appreciation.

- 8. Recognise philosophical issues truly unique to 20th C heritage a Charter!
- 9. Accompany charter with guidance on how to apply the methodology for specific issues
- 10. Develop a central source of information to provide a vehicle for information sharing & showcase solutions



Technical issues & sustainability

- 11. Acknowledge technical issues as primary challenges & address at time of listing
- 12. Acknowledge potential conflicts with green-building agenda & develop responses & solutions
- 13. Demonstrate role conservation in sustainability, lobby for inclusion of cultural sustainability in measures
- 14. Develop & share solutions for meeting green building standards.
