André van Graan is an architect and senior lecturer in architecture at the Cape Peninsula University of Technology in Cape Town, South Africa. He is currently completing his doctoral studies through the University of Cape Town. His doctoral research topic, *Negotiating Modernism in Cape Town 1918-1948*, has examined the impact that the modernist project had on the city. He has focussed on the consideration of architectural culture in this period and the socio-political implications of its introduction into a segregated colonial society. He has researched the period extensively and is working on an identification and listing of significant modern buildings in Cape Town from the early modern movement onwards as part of a professional architects' institute initiative.
