David Wixted is a heritage architect practising in Melbourne, a long time member of ICOMOS, and principal of the heritage consulting firm *heritage ALLIANCE*.

His interest in the culture of the twentieth century has ranged over the heritage of service stations, road map iconography and neon signs. His office has undertaken a number of studies focussing on wartime heritage places, the postwar recovery and modernist architecture in Victoria, and has recently investigated heritage places associated with the Second World War at Pt Nepean National Park and in the Cities of Maribyrnong, Moreland and Sunshine. The conference paper 'its got Maribyrnong written all over it' is based on work for the City of Maribyrnong where he assessed the impact of the war and how its surviving material culture might be interpreted.
