Jane, a Director of Converge Heritage + Community, specialises in defence and military heritage. Her honours thesis examined Sydney's defence network (1788-1945) and she has particular interest in the conservation of military heritage, the social significance of defence sites and the importance of examining defence sites within their strategic context. Jane has worked on numerous nineteenth and twentieth century military sites, including gun batteries, aerodromes, artillery collections, drill halls and ordnance depots. Jane's team won the ASHA Award for Best Historical Heritage Archaeological Report in 2007 (Evans Head Aerodrome AMP) and a Highly Commended in the 2008 NSW National Trust Awards (Evans Head Aerodrome Bellman Hangar CMP). Jane is a member of the Australia ICOMOS Executive Committee and the ICOMOS International Scientific Committee IcoFORT.
