Maria Leus is a professor at the department of architecture, PHL & University of Hasselt, Belgium, since 1989. She is responsible for the architectural design studio and the seminar of building structure design in the 1st year of the masters degree program, in architecture. In 1997 she accepted a position as professor in the department of conservation and restoration of monuments and sites at the Artesis University College of Design Sciences in Antwerp, Belgium, where she currently holds a professorship in 'historic city centre studies'. Over the years she has been thesis chair to several masters students as well as acted on the committee of numerous other post graduate programs.

Her PhD in engineering (2002) dealt with the structural renovation of 19th century fire proof mills. She started up the research group Re-use, which is part of the Lab of Architectural Engineering in 2007. She is editor of the local journal 'Erfgoed voor Industrie en Techniek' which diffuses research on industrial heritage in the Netherlands and Belgium.
