Tim Smith is the Deputy Director of the Heritage Branch, NSW Department of Planning (Sydney, Australia) and implements major policy, media and publications initiatives. He is also the Coordinator of the NSW Maritime Archaeology Program. Tim joined the Department in 1991 and has worked throughout the Middle East, Greece, Italy and Turkey over the past 20 years. He is currently Director-Maritime Archaeologist of the Submarine Institute of Australia (SIA) expedition at the 1915 Australian submarine AE2, Gallipoli, Turkey. Tim has coordinated numerous heritage projects documenting military wreck sites including HMAS Australia (1), HMAS Parramatta (1), and the J3 and J5 submarine wrecks near Melbourne. Tim successfully led the search for the Dutch (ex-RAN) submarine K-IX wreck near Seal Rocks, NSW (1945), and is currently Project Manager for the M24 Japanese midget submarine wreck site (1942) off Newport, Sydney.
