

The history of corrugated roofing in Australia is long and winding, but reveals many secrets for anyone looking to bring a building back to its former glory.

Buildings built before 1945 were tributes to detail in so many ways and one that is easily overlooked is the corrugated roof.

In those days there was no standard for corrugated sheeting, instead many versions of the famous roofing style that originated in the town of Gospel Oak in Britain.

This sheeting had deeper and rounder corrugations giving it a more striking pattern that changed its stripes as the sun moved overhead.

Post WWII, this style of corrugated iron was lost to us as a result of resource rationing and in the years that followed, style was replaced by imported low cost, shallow corrugated that was only ever intended as a fencing profile.






