


Helen Grant Ross

Helen Grant Ross Architect/Urbanist (d.p.l.g.) Modern Architecture Historian (D.E.A. Sorbonne) Independent Researcher. Up to 1995, her French company completed numerous buildings, urban projects and some research contracts with the Ministry of Planning. In 1990 she was appointed Lecturer at Lille School of Architecture. 1995 she moved to Bangkok to work on the design of the MRTA subway. 1997-2000 UNESCO appointed her Coordinator and Lecturer at the Royal University of Fine Arts in Phnom Penh, Cambodia. 2001-2007 Consultant on internationally funded health, culture and education infrastructure and architecture. In 2006, Building Cambodia 'New Khmer Architecture': 1953-1970, with co-author Darryl Collins, was nominated by Time Magazine, One of the 10 Best Asian Books of the Year. Over the last ten years she has worked relentlessly to promote knowledge about New Khmer Architecture through articles in the press, exhibitions, conferences and international venues.
